Hi Cathy and Steve,

In an email Wanda wrote: "The committee needs to recommend one student (emphasis on need) for the one departmental scholarship and submit one name for the COLA scholarship (based on scholarship and academic activity). There are only 2 in COLA so our candidate may not win that one."

Wanda said the applications are in the main office. I assume on Annette's desk in a folder.

I'd suggest we drop the students with incomplete applicantions (i.e., no essays) and combine JRN and MCM because we are only giving "one departmental scholarship".

Now, how to choose?

With the new set up (1 dept. & 1 COLA) it makes it difficult in choosing. Do we suggest our best candidate for the COLA and our 2nd best for the Dept.? But, what if the best doesn't win the more competitive COLA scholarship? That doesn't seem right.

So, then do we give our best candidate the Dept. scholarship and send the 2nd best up for the COLA? That doesn't seem right either. Would all departments be sending forward their 2nd best for the COLA.

Or, do we give the Dept. scholarship to the best candidate and also forward the same name (the best candidate) for the COLA award? So, then the 2nd best has no chance of getting any scholarship support.

Maybe there is something that I'm not understanding here? Maybe looking at need and academics separately would help resolve this?

For now let's rate each of the 5 candidates on a scale from 1 to 10 for both NEED and ACADEMICS. 10 being the highest/best. So each student/candidate would have 2 scores.

We can then average scores and go from there.

Email me your scores. I'll be in the main office tonight (early evening) working on this. I'll try to have mine done by tonight. The Dean's office has given no specific due date, but Wanda mentioned that they needed the names "as soon as possible."
